

Ninth-Grade Systematic Intervention Placement 2016-17 Data

TIER 1

Study hall/drop-in academic support centers

- 86 percent no longer had D/F grades
- 14 percent maintained D/F grades, but improved

TIER 2

Required academic support centers

- 32 percent no longer had D/F grades
- 64 percent maintained D/F grades, but improved
- 4 percent maintained D/F grades and did not improve

Push-in group

- 62.5 percent had no F's in sophomore core classes

TIER 3

Guided study hall

- 14 percent no longer had D/F grades
- 73 percent maintained D/F grades, but improved
- 13 percent maintained D/F grades and did not improve

Literacy lab

- Students in this class had twice the Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI) score gains of students not in the class.
- The SRI's average yearly score gain for a student is 50 points. The average yearly SRI score gain for a student in this class was 76 points, while the average yearly SRI score gain for a student not in the class was 40 points.

Note: Because reading support will be a new intervention for the 2017-18 school year, there is no data to share.
